Topic: Storytelling	Lesson: Story Telling with Crossover Characters

Lesson Plan Details:

<u>Lesson Objective and Purpose</u>	<p><i>Students will develop their own characters and learn elements of storytelling.</i></p> <p><i>Crossing over characters, students will create a skit in hopes of telling their own story.</i></p>
<u>Essential Question</u>	<u>Aim: How can I tell a story with crossover characters?</u>
<u>Resources/Materials</u>	<p>Loose Leaf</p> <p>Pencils</p> <p>Dry Erase Markers</p> <p><u>Character Development Worksheet</u></p> <p><u>Crossover Worksheet</u></p>

Lesson Progression

<u>Opening/Icebreaker/Introduction</u> (10mins)
<p>Students will enter and stand in a circle and will introduce themselves. (Name, Grade, and Fun Fact)</p> <p>The class will then begin with an improv game “Freeze Tag (The Drama Way)” to open up the class.</p>
<u>Mini-Lesson: Developing a Character (15 mins)</u>
<p>Teacher will explain today’s objective on the whiteboard. (Teacher will explain elements of character development)</p> <p>The teacher will give students handouts and explain the directions.</p> <p>Independent Work: In 5 MINS, quickly develop your character. Answer the following questions.</p>

- **Name**
- **Hometown (Fictional or Nonfiction)**
- **Quick Background**
- **Description**
- **Dislikes and Likes**
- **What show does your character come from**

Mini-Lesson: Developing a Character (25 mins)

Before Grouping students in groups, the Teacher will discuss how the scenes will be developed and how they will story tell. The teacher will quickly go over the elements of story telling.

The teacher will group students into a group of 4. Students will pair up together and discuss their characters. On the Crossover Worksheet, student groups will fill the sheet out and discuss what their scene will be about. (Structured Improv)

Students will perform their scenes for the class.
